The first edition of "Flowers of Guanabara" was published in the year 2000, the second edition came out in 2007, and the third edition was released in 2010. Edroza Matute's books have sold more than 1.5 million copies. The literary magazine "Correio da Cidadania" rated this book as one of the top twenty books of all time to show social problems faced by Brazilians. Editions (three) (only Flowers of Guanabara):

It has been translated into English by Betsy Wing and published by Caravelle Press (U.S.) 2013; Italian; Chinese; Turkish; Spanish; French; German; Dutch; Portuguese (Brazil). The book was adapted into a film, "The Flowers of Guanabara," directed by Caco Carvalho. It won best feature film at the 2008 International Film Festival in Germany. In 2008, the novel was chosen as one of the best Brazilian books that year by The Clarín newspaper. And in 2010, it was chosen as one of the best books from Brazil's past by (Brazilian Ministry of Culture). In 2013, it was selected for inclusion in the UNESCO Memory of the World Programme and inscribed on UNESCO's Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity. It has been translated into Italian and published by Il Sole 24 Ore (Italy).
